






TWEEN ZONE: 6TH-8TH GRADE EVENTS

Library Resources: Cloudlibrary



Cloudlibrary offers access to a variety of ebooks and audiobooks. In addition, the app offers self-checkout options for physical library materials, so you don't have to carry your library card around!

Getting started with CloudLibrary:

- 1. Download the CloudLibrary app or go to yourcloudlibrary.com
- 2. Enter your state (Iowa) and Library (Orange City Public Library).

3. Log in using your 13-digit library card number (no letter) and 7-digit phone number (10 digits if not 712).

Opportunities:

The library is partnering with PIECE to enable weekly one-on-one English Language (EL) lessons! The PIECE team trains any individual



in the community willing to donate their time to tutor an adult EL student while building authentic and reciprocal relationships. Materials and resources are provided and bi-monthly meetings are offered to support and equip tutors. No previous training or experience is required and it is not necessary to speak another language to participate! Applications for tutors and students can be found at the library. 
Staff Pick:

This month's staff pick from the library collection, recommended by Gail Marincovich, is <u>Virgil</u>

<u>Wander</u> by Leif Enger. Here's what Gail has to say about the book:

"Every once in a while, a book comes along that is such a work of art, it deserves its own little shelf.

<u>Virgil Wander</u> is one of those books. Leif Enger welcomes us to Greenstone, Minnesota, a small



town where hard luck, humor, and a sense of community bind its citizens together. With spoton dialogue, intelligence, and wit, Enger creates a cast of characters who are eccentric, flawed, and deeply human. And like a parent, Enger wisely and compassionately looks beyond the behavior to find the goodness in each of his "children." We find it, too. As the story unfolds, Enger's vivid descriptions connect us to place as well, immersing us in the climate, landscape, and culture of this struggling northern outback. Enger's writing, in my opinion, is at a level rarely reached by contemporary authors. What a tremendous gift."

<u>Virgil Wander</u> is available at the Orange City Public Library in both normal and large print, and it is also available as an ebook or audiobook through the Libby app.
