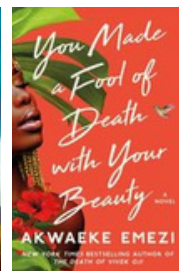
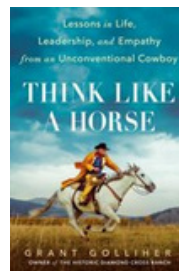
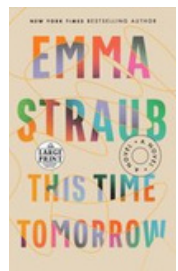
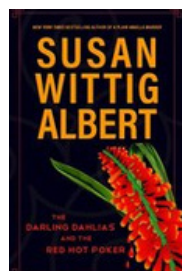
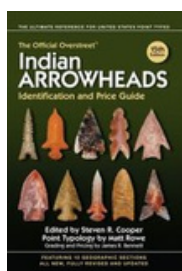
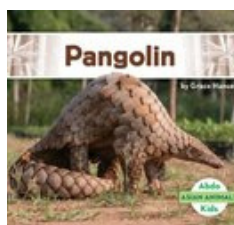
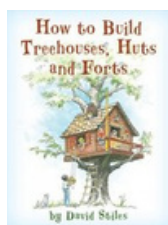
## Books on Juneteenth
