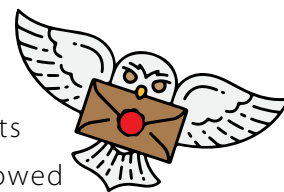

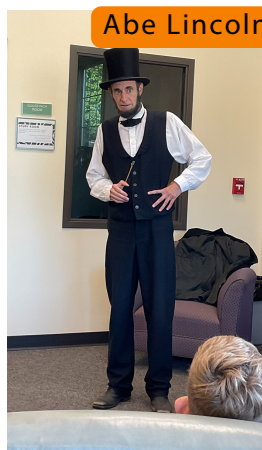

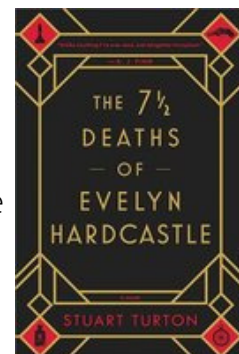

The 7 1/2 Deaths of Evelyn Hardcastle by Stuart Turton.

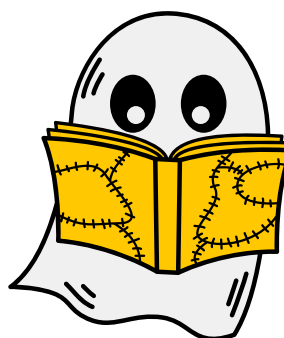
