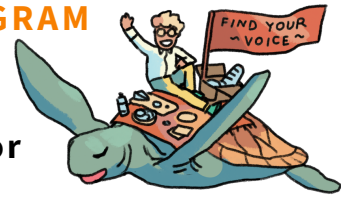

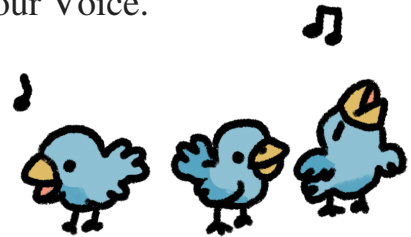
Dear Readers,

Thank you to everyone who participated in our programs this year. We hope that Orange City Public Library was able to help you Find Your Voice.

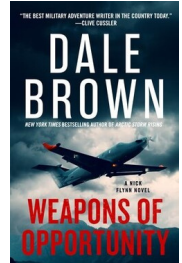
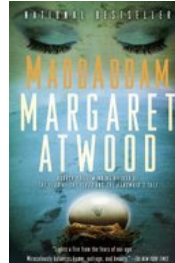
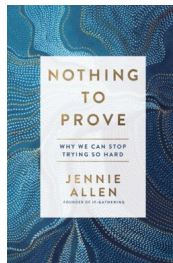
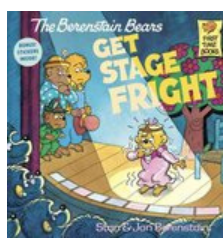
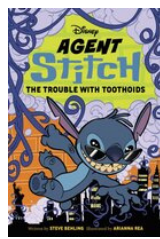
